Recycling

All residents and businesses within Scott Township are required to recycle per Ordinance # 9-10-13. All residents must recycle: Newspaper, Glass Containers, plastic containers, and metal containers.

**Curbside recycling collection** — Each waste hauling company is required to provide a minimum of once a month recycling collection for their customers. Contact your hauler for a complete list of acceptable items, collection schedule and fees. For more information contact the Recycling coordinator at (570) 784-4532.

The ordinance requires all waste haulers to register with the Township as an AUTHORIZED HAULER. A complete list of registered haulers compliant with the ordinance can be found on the Township website. All Authorized collector's must provide for both the removal of garbage and recycling.

## **FALL LEAF COLLECTION**



Begins on Monday October 15th and runs until Wednesday November 21, 2018. THERE IS NO SET SCHEDULE FOR LEAF COLLECTION. The leaf truck has a set route to follow around the Township, and the frequency of

Collection along that route depends upon how many leaves are out for collection. We ask that you arrange leaves in a row instead of in a pile, and rake them as close to the road as possible. Please also remove all foreign objects and stones for the leaves to be collected, as these items damage equipment resulting in costly delays of the collection process. NO bagged leaves.


## **Township News**
