



## Recycling

**MANDATORY RECYCLING** All residents and businesses within Scott Township are required to recycle per Ordinance # 9-10-13. All residents must recycle: Newspaper, Glass, plastic and metal containers.

**CURBSIDE RECYCLING** — Each waste hauling company is required to provide a minimum of once a month recycling collection for their customers. Contact your hauler for a complete list of acceptable items, the collection schedule and fees. For more information contact the Recycling coordinator at 570-784-4532.

The ordinance requires all waste haulers to register with the Township as an AUTHORIZED HAULER. A complete list of registered haulers compliant with the ordinance can be found on the Township website.

**All Authorized collectors must provide for both the removal of garbage and recycling.**

**SPRING YARD WASTE** — The Public Works department will be collecting yard waste at the curb during the **third week in April (15th–19th)**. Acceptable items include leaves and garden waste. Rake items to the curb where they will be vacuumed. Please make sure piles are free of rocks and other debris that is harmful to the collection equipment. There is not a per street collection schedule, crews will be collecting yard waste at the curb during **this week only**.

The Bloomsburg Compost Site opens for the season on Wednesday March 13, 2024 (weather permitting). The site is open every Wednesday and Saturday from mid March until Thanksgiving. Everyone entering the site must show Identification as proof of address. There is no admittance outside of the scheduled open hours. The following items are acceptable: leaves, brush, branches up to six feet in length and four inches in diameter and garden residue.

**GRASS CLIPPING ARE NOT ALLOWED.** Township residents may pick up mulch or compost (while available), Loading is the responsibility of the resident. **ID REQUIRED**—all vehicles must stop at the attendant booth and show ID. NOTICE there is a new traffic flow as shown above. There is no fee for Scott Township residents.

**Special Note:** Christmas trees can be dropped off weekdays throughout the month of January from 8:00am until 3:00pm

## **FALL LEAF COLLECTION -**

Begins **Monday October 14th** and runs until **Wednesday November 20, 2024.**

THERE IS NO SET SCHEDULE FOR LEAF COLLECTION. The leaf truck has a set route to follow around the Township, and the frequency of collection along that route depends upon how many leaves are out for collection.

We ask that you arrange leaves in a row instead of in a pile, and rake them to the berm of the road. Please also remove all foreign objects and stones from the leaves to be collected, as these items damage equipment resulting in costly delays of the collection process. **NO bagged leaves.**

## **What you should know about Flood Safety**

- Make a family emergency communication plan and include pets.

- Never drive or walk through flooded streets; Turn Around, Don't Drown! Do not go through flood waters.
